## • Master's of Occupational Therapy Degree

Motion (Jolson/Smith): that the Council approve the Master's Degree in Occupational Therapy Program, and notes that this program will replace the current Bachelor of Medical Rehabilitation (Occupational Therapy) Degree.

## • Bachelor of Science in Environmental Science Degree

Motion (Smith/Lécuyer): that Council support the establishment of the Bachelor of Environmental Science Degree Program, and

that Council approve \$60.0 in funds in 2002/03 and in subsequent years.

## 5. Funding Request – Campus Manitoba

Motion (Smith/Melnick): that the Council approve \$81.0 in the current budget year for a technology refit for Campus Manitoba Centres, and an annual increase in base funding of \$25.0 per year, beginning in 2003/04, to establish a regular upgrade cycle of Campus Manitoba infrastructure.
