Welcome to *The Wedding Planner Project*

General Information

The purpose of the first session is to provide an opportunity for you to

- develop an understanding of the project requirements
- become familiar with the information contained in the *Project Resource Package*
- share ideas related to the project in a brainstorming session

After the first project session the following conditions apply:

- Two additional classwork periods will be provided.
- Your teacher cannot assist you in developing or revising your project.
- You may conduct research on your project between work periods.
- You must submit an individual project that reflects your own work.

Guidelines for *The Wedding Planner Project*

You are a wedding planner and have been hired to plan a wedding for the bride and groom who are working out of province. They have given you some specific guidelines, and they trust you will plan a wedding they will remember forever, within a set of guidelines.

In doing this project the following scenarios and requirements apply:

1. Saturday, June 14 is the date of the wedding, with the ceremony to begin at 2 p.m.
2. The wedding party will consist of eight people; the bride and groom, three attendants for the bride, and three attendants for the groom.
3. One hundred and forty (140) people will be attending the wedding, including immediate family and wedding party.
4. You are to make the final decision on the clothes for the bride and groom. They have sent you pictures of styles they like.
5. Flowers must be ordered for the wedding party, parents of the bride and groom, grandparents of the bride and groom, and master of ceremonies.
6. You must arrange for the:
 - music
 - videographer
 - photographer
 - location for wedding pictures
 - reception location
 - dinner menu
 - cake
 - thank-you gifts for the wedding guests
 - other
7. The cost for invitations, reply cards, thank-you cards, and postage is \$650.00 (including tax).
8. A minimum \$250.00 donation/fee is required for the use of a location to hold the ceremony (including tax).
9. The marriage license must be acquired at a cost of \$75.00 (including tax).
10. The bride and groom want to have a marriage certificate, which will cost \$100.00 (including tax).
11. Hair and makeup for the bride will cost \$150.00 (including tax). A haircut for the groom will cost \$25.00 (including tax).
12. As a wedding planner, you can add “special” touches to the wedding day.
13. You must charge a **fee-for-service** of 10-20% of the wedding costs.
14. Taxes are not included in any prices given, unless otherwise specified.
15. The bride and groom have given you a budget between \$11 000.00 and \$17 000.00.

Directions for *The Wedding Planner* Project

Your completed project must include the following information:

- a letter to your clients outlining the wedding you have planned for them
- a detailed budget
- **a justification of any assumptions or decisions you make in completing your project**

Your completed project must

- be separate from this *Project Resource Package* booklet
- be well organized and clearly presented with an introduction and conclusion
- include your calculations
- be written or printed in blue or black ink or printed using black ink from a printer

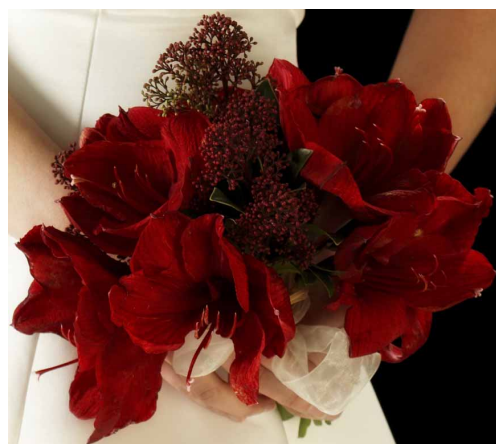

- Basic wedding package \$3 200.00 includes two 8 x10 photos, five 5 x 7 photos, and 1 leather wedding album (with bride & groom's names and wedding date engraved on front cover) with approximately 200 photos of the special day.
- Photographer will photograph the bride and her attendants before the wedding and during the ceremony, and will remain at the reception for pictures until 9 p.m.
- Additional time for the photographer at the reception may be booked at a cost of \$100.00 per hour.
- Should you require additional photos, they may be ordered at an additional cost.
- Photos are taken digitally. A picture CD can be purchased at a cost of \$300.00.

Photographer 2: Wendy Portrait

- Professional Photographer for 25 years.
- Member of Canadian Professional Photographers Association.
- Specializes in weddings.
- Basic wedding package \$2 000.00 includes pictures of bride and attendants prior to the ceremony, pictures of the ceremony, pictures of the wedding party after the ceremony, and reception pictures until 7 p.m. A wedding album of approximately 160 photos, three 8 x 10 photos, five 5 x 7 photos, and ten 4 x 6 photos.
- Additional time for the photographer at the reception may be booked at a cost of \$125.00 per hour.

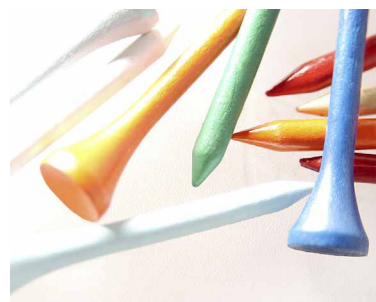
