Terms	Treaty of Utrecht 1713	Treaty of Paris 1763
Region in Northwest and around Hudson's Bay	Under British control	Under British control
Newfoundland	British colony	British colony
Acadia (New Brunswick, Nova Scotia, Cape Breton Island, Prince Edward Island)	Nova Scotia is British colony; Cape Breton Island and the rest of Acadia remains under France	All of Acadia becomes British colonies
Québec	France	Becomes English colony and is made smaller
First Nations	Iroquois made British subjects Hurons, Mi'kmaq retain alliances with France	Large tracts of lands to the west and south of Québec are reserved as Indian hunting grounds
Ohio Valley (in the United States)	France	Part of reserved land for Indians
