


# Model Timeline

Your task is to create a timeline similar to the model shown above.

1. On legal-sized paper or larger, draw a straight line in the middle of the page.
2. At regular intervals, mark off vertical lines to indicate different time periods.
  - ⇒ Each vertical line equals 1000 years.
  - ⇒ Where there is a large jump forward in time, use the fast forward symbol (») to indicate the jump.
3. Using the list of prehistory events, indicate each event at the right spot on the timeline. Also add these dates:
  - the current year (at the far right end of the timeline)
  - 1 CEIf the event spans a long time period, use the first date to indicate the beginning of the period (e.g., 2,500,000 BCE – Old Stone Age begins).
4. Give each event a title and add a visual symbol or image
5. Add to the timeline two other events in prehistory that you have discovered in your research.
