8321 ADVANCED HAIRCUTTING AND CHEMICAL TEXTURE (12B) 40S/40E/40M

Course Description

This course focuses on advanced haircutting and the theoretical and practical application of chemical smoothing and relaxing of hair. Students will also demonstrate two services on Afro texture and other natural hair types. Students learn all of Unit D3: Chemical Smoothing and Relaxing Hair in this course.
