# CHECKLIST

## GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS FOR THE SENIOR YEARS FRENCH IMMERSION PROGRAM

Students must earn at least 14 credits from courses taught in French to meet the requirements of the French Immersion Program Diploma. The following checklist will help you determine if you have the required number of credits.

### Part 1

- Indicate with “**FR**” courses completed in the French language toward the French Immersion Program Diploma.
- Indicate with “**EN**” courses taken in the English language.
- Add up the number of “**FR**” and “**EN**” entries in each row (compulsory and optional) and indicate this total in the last column (where applicable).
- Calculate the sum of the last column to ensure the minimum number of credits for graduation is reached.

Note: Put a check mark beside compulsory and optional credits listed below as credit is achieved.

## CHECKLIST

### GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS FOR THE SENIOR YEARS FRENCH IMMERSION PROGRAM

#### Part 2

Remember that to meet the requirements of the French Immersion Program Diploma, students must earn 14 credits from courses taught in French.

How to determine if you have the required number of courses taught in French:

- Calculate a sum for “**FR**” courses in each of Grades 9, 10, 11 and 12 columns on the previous page.
- Ensure that a correct minimum of courses (compulsory and optional) have been taught in French and are distributed as follows:
  - in Grade 9, a minimum of 4 credits from courses taught in French;
  - in Grade 10, a minimum of 4 credits from courses taught in French;
  - in Grade 11, a minimum of 3 credits from courses taught in French; and
  - in Grade 12, a minimum of 3 credits from courses taught in French.
- Indicate the sum for “**FR**” courses earned at each grade level in the spaces provided in the following table.
- Add up these four results and write the total in the last column.
