The Big Picture The following considerations are useful when developing career development programming:

- Involve all staff in planning career development programming Maintain responsibility for
- determining programming guidelines, along with related resources, staffing, and time required for its successful implementation Encourage parental and parent
 - advisory council involvement in program planning Ensure that career development
 - programs and counselling services are aligned with the school's Ensure that career development mission
 - programming is responsive to students' developmental needs from Kindergarten to postsecondary

ing Considerations Provide professional learning and planning time for teachers so that the career development skills achieved by students at one grade serve as the foundation for, and articulate with, the next grade
