News in Review is a series of 60 minute educational programs designed by teachers for integrated curriculum instruction. It is an effective learning tool for Canadian studies, global studies, history, social science, and media literacy. Each *News in Review* segment is crafted to give students and teachers a timely and concise examination of Canadian and world issues. Footage from CBC's archives helps provide historical context. A comprehensive resource guide written by experienced educators supplies background information. *News in Review* is closed captioned.

Re-purposed for educational use as a subscription series, each news program is up to 60 minutes long and covers four selected news events of national or international importance. Each series consists of eight programs and eight printed resource guides, and is suitable for Grades 7 – 12.

Because the resource has relevance to several curriculum areas and significant value in its timeliness, Manitoba Education, Citizenship and Youth has acquired the duplication rights to the series for 2009/2010. Teachers may subscribe to the entire series using the [News in Review Media Duplication Order Form 2009/2010](#) to receive the programs and printed resource guides as they are produced. The 2009-2010 series is available in DVD format only. **The cost per subscription is \$160.00** (including PST and GST) for 8 programs and 8 printed resource guides.

Individual programs may also be requested for duplication at a cost of \$15.00 per program. A separate order form is required for each of the eight programs as they are received by IRU from the CBC. Schools may retain programs for the life of the DVD, that is, a non-erasure clause is in effect. Another unique feature of the subscription is the ability to repackage the segments into different sequences to meet teaching requirements should the teacher wish to bring similar topics together. Please note that the actual segments may not be edited, shortened or altered. Subject and season indexes are available from the CBC website.
