INTRODUCTION

References for Selecting Learning Resources

Education for Sustainable Development: A List of Titles with Suggested Uses for Senior 2 to Senior 4: A Reference for Selecting Learning Resources (April 2006) is a reference tool to help educators select student and teacher learning resources related to sustainable development where sustainable development concepts are woven into various subject areas.

Learning Resources Review

Teacher-evaluators reviewed the learning resources listed in this bibliography in November 2005. They identified a range of learning resources related to the outcomes in subject areas where sustainable development concepts were present. These subject areas included

- Senior 2 Science
- Senior 3 Current Topics in the Sciences
- Senior 2 Social Studies: Geographical Issues of the 21st Century
- Senior 4 Social Studies: World Issues
- Senior 3 and Senior 4 Physics
- Senior 3 and Senior 4 Biology
- Senior 3 Chemistry
- Senior 4 English Language Arts

The titles selected represent a range of resources that could be used to address Manitoba student learning outcomes in a number of subject areas. Because many of the resources are cross-curricular, each individual title may reference several subject areas, but may support some subjects to a greater degree than others.

When using this bibliography to select learning and teaching resources, teachers should consider how the resources meet the learning requirements of students, the perspectives of their student population, as well as local decisions made related to the delivery of potentially sensitive content. Information on a specific learning resource may be obtained from the descriptive information in this bibliography, as well as from the supplier, published reviews, colleagues, and an examination of the resource.

Definitions of Suggested Uses

The following terms and definitions are used in this bibliography to describe the learning resources.

The suggested uses listed under each title in the bibliography indicate:

Grade and Audience and Subject

- **Student Depth:** Identifies student learning resources that provide especially effective learning experiences for students for a particular grouping of learning outcomes.
- **Teacher Reference:** Provides background information to assist teachers in implementing the learning outcomes.
- **Subject and Grade Level:** Each resource in this bibliography has been identified in terms of how it relates to several subject areas.

The suggested uses in the bibliography also indicate which United Nations Perspective and/or Manitoba Dimension the title addresses, as well as where in the Manitoba curricula the title might be potentially useful.

- **United Nations Perspectives with Manitoba Dimensions***: In 1987 the United Nations Report *Our Common Future* used the term sustainable development in which were discussed the interrelationships of the environment and the economy and the health of society for addressing needs today and in the future.
