2. Written Knowledge Tests

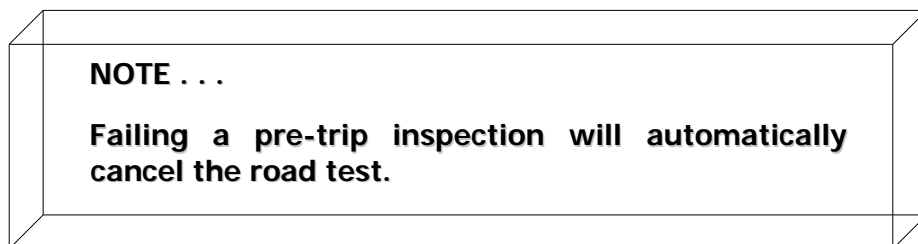
For Classes 1, 2, 3, and 4, tests include a sign recognition test; a written knowledge test pertaining to the class of licence sought; and in the case of driving a school bus, a written school bus knowledge test. These tests are based on the Manitoba Driver's Handbook; the Professional Driver's Manual, and this handbook. When preparing for a written test, keep in mind it is not an open-book format.

3. Authorized Instruction

Upon successful completion of the written knowledge test(s), an individual who is in the process of obtaining his/her full licence will be issued an "Authorized Instruction" licence in order to train and become familiar with the vehicle. Other school bus driver trainees are permitted in the vehicle during this stage, but should be kept to a minimum. Student transport is not permitted at this point. Where the individual is pursuing a Class 1, 2, 3, or 4 driver's licence, he/she may be accompanied by a "supervising driver" who has held the same class of licence for a minimum of two years.

4. Road Tests

A road test must be completed in a vehicle appropriate to the class of licence sought. To acquire a Class 2 licence, a school bus vehicle is required. A pre-trip inspection of the school bus must be performed in addition to the road test. Fees for the road test are not refundable if the test is cancelled due to the vehicle failing to meet vehicle standards under *The Highway Traffic Act* and its Regulations.
