Dear Homeschooling Parent(s):

Welcome to homeschooling for the 2018-2019 school year. We hope that homeschooling will be a very rewarding experience for you and your children.

This package includes a **Student Notification Form** that must be completed annually for each student and submitted by **September 1st or 30 days** after establishing your homeschool.

There are four steps in the process to homeschool in Manitoba:

- STEP 1: Notifying** Parent(s)/Guardian(s) complete, sign and submit a **Student Notification Form** (see page following) for **EACH** school-age child **every year** they are homeschooled.
- STEP 2: Processing** The Homeschooling Office processes the Student Notification Form(s).
- Homeschooling liaisons may contact parent(s) to clarify information.
 - A Student Notification Form for any child who was notified in the previous school year as a homeschool student will not be processed until both the January and June Progress Reports have been received by the Homeschooling Office.
- STEP 3: Confirmation** The Homeschooling Office mails a confirmation of notification letter to parent(s) after Student Notification Forms are processed.
- STEP 4: Reporting** Parent(s) complete and submit a January and June Progress Report for each student.
