## Addition Race



Material: Game board
Number cube
Symbol cube
Different coloured counter for each player
Players: Two or three
Rules: $\quad$ The first player rolls the cubes to start a number sentence. For example, if the player rolls " 3 " and "one more than" then the number of spaces to move must be "4". If the cubes read " 5 " and "less than", then the number of spaces to move can be anything less than 5. A player must have the exact number in order to finish. For example if a player needs a 2 to finish but rolls a "2" and "more than" then she misses a turn and play passes to the next player.

Note: $\quad$ Have students say a number sentence with each roll of the cubes. Example "One more than 3 is 4 " or " 2 is less than 5."
