Multiplication Game

Material: Game board

One calculator

Four sets of question cards:

Easier 2 points pie Easy 4 points orange Hard 6 points ball

Harder 8 points target

Players: Two

Rules: Players determine who will go first. At the start and whenever they land

on a question space players choose the difficulty level they want and draw a card from the appropriate pile. They use pencil and paper to calculate the answer and the other player verifies it using a calculator.

If the answer is incorrect, the player does not move.

Variation: Players who answer incorrectly must move back the number of spaces

equal to the value of the question.
