

**GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS  
SENIOR YEARS FRENCH IMMERSION PROGRAM**

Out of a total of 30 credits, a minimum of 14 credits from courses taught in French are required to obtain the provincial diploma in French Immersion. At each grade in Grade 9 and in Grade 10, a minimum of 4 credits must be completed in French and at each grade in Grade 11 and in Grade 12 a minimum of 3 credits must be completed in French.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students must meet the entrance requirements of the post-secondary education (college or university), training, or work situation they intend to pursue.</li> <li>• Within the optional subject areas, students must complete one Grade 11 credit and one Grade 12 credit.</li> <li>• <b>Note:</b> School-Initiated Courses (SICs) and Student-Initiated Projects (SIPs) may be used to fulfil the graduation requirements within the optional credits to a maximum of 11 and 3 respectively. Depending on the different requirements of the four school programs, the number of possible SICs used as optional credits may vary.</li> <li>• Out of a total of 30 credits, a minimum of 14 credits from courses taught in French are required to obtain the provincial diploma in French.</li> </ul>	

**Note:** Manitoba Education, Citizenship and Youth (MECY) recently mandated two new Physical Education/Health Education (PE/HE) courses at grades 11 and 12 as a result of recommendations flowing from the *Healthy Kids, Healthy Futures* Task Force Report. This change will bring Manitoba Senior Years graduation requirements 29 credits for those students graduating in 2008-2009 and to 30 credits for those students graduating in 2009-2010 and beyond.
