The Early Start French courses for Kindergarten to Grade 3 aim to provide students with an exposure to the French language in order to foster a positive attitude towards learning French, to introduce simple language structures for purposeful communication, to provide a context for the application of developing literacy skills, and to develop an awareness of Francophone cultures.



In highly structured learning situations, the teacher introduces thematic texts, always framed by authentic oral communication that engages students in using new vocabulary and simple language structures.
