Status Cards — Role-Play

Instructions: Make yourself a tag to wear so that everyone can see the symbol of the group to which you belong. Do not reveal directly what the second sentence says about your status or importance, but act according to what it says. You may not openly state you are better than another group, and you may not openly insult anyone during the role-play.

You are a Star. Your group has a higher status than the Circles.

You are a Circle. Your group has a higher status than the Triangles.

You are a Triangle. Your group has a higher status than the Squares.

You are a Square. Your group has a lower status than the Stars.
