
## Triangular European Trade c. 1450-1800s—Key


## Europe (Portugal, Spain, Holland, France, England)

- Export goods to Africa to purchase slaves
- Import sugar, cotton, tobacco, molasses, rum from the Americas

## The Americas

Slaves taken from Africa to work on sugar and tobacco plantations and later on the cotton plantations in the southern United States.







## Africa (especially the west coast)

African Kingdoms purchased guns, textiles (e.g., cotton), beads, shells, horses, some foods, and liquors in exchange for slave workers.
