Thank you for your interest in the Manitoba Education, Citizenship and Youth (MECY) Rural and Northern Clinician Bursary. The purpose of the bursary is to support school divisions in the recruitment and retention of staff in specialized professions and hard to fill geographic areas.

The funding is available to rural and northern school divisions. The divisions are responsible for developing a bursary that will support training of existing teachers or post-secondary students in speech-language pathology, psychology, occupational therapy, physiotherapy or other specialty areas in return for service.

School divisions are responsible for choosing a suitable candidate and negotiating the return of service agreement. It is important to note that in order to be eligible for the bursary, the student must enter into a return of service agreement with a school division in rural or northern Manitoba not with Manitoba Education Citizenship and Youth.
