## 1. Minutes of the July 13/01 meeting

 Licensed Practical Nursing Certificate Program Expansion to Serve First Nations/Metis Communities

Motion (McKay/Macdonald): that Council support the expansion of the Licensed Practical Nursing Certificate Program to First Nations/Metis Communities as presented, and

that Council approve an amount of \$80.0 in the first year (2001/02), and \$230.0 in each of the next three years from CEI, and \$35.0 for each year of the program from COPSE from the University Other Operating fund. It was noted that Employment and Training Services will also provide \$35.0 in each year of the program.

## 5. Campus Manitoba – Web-Based Admission and Registration System

At its April 6, 2001 meeting, Council ratified its support for the transfer of \$300,000 to the Campus Manitoba account to be held in trust until a formal proposal was presented to Council.

At its September 14, 2001 meeting, Council passed the following motion:

Motion (McKay/Green): that Council approve the release of funds in the amount of \$300,000 to develop the Campus Manitoba Web-Based Admission and Registration System Project.
