FRENCH IMMERSION CONFERENCE

OVERVIEW

The **French Immersion Leadership in Manitoba: Empowering Leaders for Success** conference, held on May 3, 2023, included over 200 school and system leaders who offer the French Immersion Program, as well as educational partners from across the province. Participants were given the opportunity to network, explore and engage with colleagues regarding the new French Immersion Policy, while reflecting on the question, *Who am I as a French immersion leader and what is my role in the full implementation of the French Immersion Program*?

With a view on the past, present and future of French immersion in Manitoba, highlights of the conference included the following:

The Minister of Manitoba Education and Early Childhood Learning welcomed participants and recognized the importance of the shared partnership and commitment to French immersion education across our province.

The Deputy Minister of Education and Early Childhood Learning discussed Manitoba's vision for student success and how the

French Immersion Program builds upon this vision byfocusing on students' French language proficiency, and on building their confidence and pride as plurilingual members of society.

The Coordinator of the French Language Education Policy & Planning Unit anchored participants in an understanding of the vision of the French Immersion Program. Participants were asked to reflect on



their role as a leader and to keep the vision of the Program at the forefront, with an understanding that their work ensures students in every French immersion school in our province are provided with a rich experience where they can **develop their French language proficiency, achieve academic success, and cultivate their plurilingual identity.**

STARTING WITH THE PAST

The conference program began with a **video** of words of wisdom from Sœur Dumesnil, principal of the first French immersion school in Manitoba, who shared the beginnings of the French Immersion Program, provided recommendations to guide leaders in their professional journeys and paved the way for future generations of leaders. What we heard:

87.7% of respondents answered 'very' or 'extremely' when asked if the video of Sœur Dumesnil supported them in their role as a leader to strengthen the French Immersion Program.

EXPLORING THE PRESENT

In a video presentation, students from across Manitoba shared their experiences in the French Immersion Program, allowing participants a glimpse into their current realities and the chance to reflect on the extent to which the vision of the French Immersion Program is being realized in our schools.

What we heard:

94.7% of respondents answered 'very' or 'extremely' when asked if the video *Student Voices* supported them in their role as a leader to strengthen the French Immersion Program.

- The video featuring student voices was impactful. It made me reflect on our programming, approach, and attitude as educators and leaders in the field of French immersion.

A panel discussion took place and panelists, who were all of French immersion leaders from the field, shared their thoughts on what they heard in the student video presentation and offered their perspectives on the role of leaders by discussing the following



question: As we go forward, how do we lead in our schools to strengthen the Program and to ensure that students develop their language proficiency, achieve academic success and cultivate their plurilingual identity?

What we heard:

82.4% of respondents answered 'very' or 'extremely' when asked if the *Panel Discussion: Leadership Perspectives* supported them in their role as a leader to strengthen the French Immersion Program.

- I thoroughly enjoyed hearing the leadership perspectives, as I often find learning from my colleagues to be the most beneficial.
- The multiple voices and perspectives of the panelists allowed for learning and conversations.

LAUNCHING THE NEW FRENCH IMMERSION POLICY

In 2022, Manitoba's K to 12 Education Action Plan was released and included a commitment to strengthen the French immersion policy. This commitment was met with the launch of the new French Immersion in Manitoba Policy, which included a presentation with an overview the structure the policy, principal changes from the previous policy and a review of new sections comprising of concrete and actionable steps. Five afternoon sessions further allowed participants to delve deeply into the foundations and the full implementation of the Program, as well as familiarize themselves with school self-assessment tools. Participants were provided with a copy of *The French Immersion Policy in Manitoba*, a summary table of the full implementation of the Program, Implementation Guidelines, as well as school self-assessment tools. What we heard:

- 84.2% of respondents answered 'very' or 'extremely' when asked if the overview and exploration of the new French Immersion Policy in Manitoba supported them in their role as a leader to strengthen the French Immersion Program.
- 72% of respondents answered 'very' or 'extremely' when asked if the afternoon workshops supported them in their role as a leader to strengthen the French Immersion Program.
- 96.5% of respondents answered 'very' or 'extremely' when asked if the conference materials provided supported them as leaders in the full implementation of the French Immersion Program.

New French Immersion Policy in Manitoba:

A BILINGUAL APPROACH

To meet the linguistic needs of all leaders, a bilingual approach to the conference was adopted. It was important to consider both languages, French and English, in order to develop a mutual understanding of the bilingual nature of the students in our schools. To eliminate communication barriers, presenters modelled an approach where information was shared in both languages, simultaneous interpretation from French to English was available, and support materials were bilingual.

What we heard:

87.7% of respondents answered 'very' or 'extremely' when asked if the bilingual format of the conference supported a positive learning environment.

- Bilingual format provided a sense of belonging especially for all participants allowing all voices to be heard. This was welcoming, beneficial and inclusive.
- We have leaders in our French immersion schools who do not speak the language but who are strong advocates for the program. The formatting of the presentation gave them entry to the learning and conversations.
- As an English-speaking individual, I felt valued and like I belonged at the conference. Thank you for going out of your way to ensure all were included and for recognizing the importance of all leaders in the program and how we can all contribute to continuing to build its success.

OVERALL CONFERENCE IMPACT: EMPOWERING LEADERS FOR SUCCESS

The conference provided leaders with the opportunity to become familiar with the policy and support documents, consider their leadership practices, and explore new ideas with colleagues while deepening their understanding of the French Immersion Program. The various components of the conference allowed participants to reflect on the key question: *Who am I as a French immersion leader and what is my role in the full implementation of the French Immersion Program?* This reflection led to thinking about how they bring the vision of the Program to life and what they should prioritize to ensure that students develop their language proficiency, achieve academic success and cultivate their plurilingual identity.

What we heard:

Upon considering the impact of the conference as a whole, 100% of respondents indicated that they felt better equipped in their role as a leader to support the full implementation of the French Immersion Program; of these respondents, 77.2% answered being "very" or "extremely" better equipped.

- Attending this conference grew my understanding of French Immersion in Manitoba and how I can better support my French Immersion administrators and teachers within our division.

- Knowing expectations, successes and challenges of other schools supports understanding and planning for next steps.

NEXT STEPS

Going forward, respondents were asked to identify possible initiatives, collaborations or materials that would further support the full implementation of the French Immersion Program; the Bureau de l'éducation française (BEF) will review this feedback as we consider future initiatives.

What we heard:

Respondents indicated that professional learning, networking, collaboration, integration of French culture, oral language and mentorship would further support the full implementation of the French Immersion Program.

- I would like to have more PD days for my staff so that they can familiarize themselves with the new protocols and materials.
- Professional development around inclusion for French Immersion teachers.
- Pedagogy training for teachers—how to teach second languages.
- J'aimerais travailler en collaboration avec les gens du BEF.
- Absolutely looking at working at developing our French culture in our school and community.
- Moving forward, continued collaboration of French Immersion leaders would support implementation, including the opportunity to visit and observe a variety of school contexts.
- A mentorship program for French Immersion leaders, especially those within first 5 years, would be a supportive initiative to assist in the full implementation of the Program.
- Le réseautage est essentiel pour faire vivre le Programme.
- Nous anticipons utiliser plusieurs de ces matériaux avec les enseignants du Programme d'immersion de notre division scolaire.

Conclusion:

The *French Immersion Leadership in Manitoba: Empowering Leaders for Success* conference inspired and guided leaders, enabling them to collectively move forward with renewed momentum and strengthen the French Immersion Program for the benefit of our students.
