

# PROVINCIAL SCHOOL LEADERSHIP FRAMEWORK ADVISORY TEAM TERMS OF REFERENCE

## PURPOSE

The Provincial School Leadership Framework Advisory Team will provide advice in the development of the *Provincial School Leadership Framework*.

The Provincial School Leadership Framework is a priority action of *Manitoba's K to 12 Education Action Plan*, Manitoba Education and Early Childhood Learning's response to the recommendations of the Commission on K to 12 Education.

## ROLE OF TEAM MEMBERS

Advisory Team members will engage in thoughtful dialogue, and provide their expert guidance and advice to develop shared understandings in the following aspects of the Provincial School Leadership Framework:

- the knowledge, skills, and behaviours of school leaders as identified from artifacts within Manitoba school divisions and from the literature on effective school leadership
- a review and analysis of school leadership framework structures, including selected school leadership frameworks from Canada and abroad
- promising practices identified through the Principal Learning Networks
- a review of implementation options for the Provincial School Leadership Framework

## MEMBERSHIP

The Advisory Team will be comprised of members from the following organizations, for a period of 12 months, based on organizational recommendations:

## TIMELINES AND MEETINGS

From May 2022 to March 2023, virtual meetings will occur every 4 to 6 weeks for an approximate duration of 1.5 to 2.0 hours. Engagements will also take place through email correspondence to share information and pose questions for reflective responses.

## REPORTING STRUCTURE

The Project Lead for the Provincial School Leadership Framework will chair the Advisory Team. Staff from Manitoba Education and Early Childhood Learning will facilitate and support the work of the Advisory Team.

The Advisory Team reviews and reflects on all content and structure inputs related to the project which informs the overall development of the Provincial School Leadership Framework. Recommendations will be arrived at by majority consensus. In cases where consensus is not achieved, opinions will be recorded.

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
