

Reporting Test Results

- The provincial test counts for 20% of student's final course grade.
- The provincial test result must be indicated separately from final course grade on report card and in school file.
- For each participating school and school division, the department prepares profiles using results from all completed scoring sheets for students whose test result counts as a provincial test mark.
- For each school division, the department prepares a *Marking Accuracy and Consistency* report based on the re-marking of a sample of test booklets at the department. Booklets are returned to schools and the report is sent to school divisions within three months of test administration.
- Schools and school divisions are to include an analysis of their results in a report to the community, along with appropriate contextual background information.
