Re: Provincial Assessments and Tests Schedule (2018/2019)

Manitoba Education and Training wishes to inform you of the provincial tests and assessments schedule for the 2018/2019 school year.

Grades 3 and 4 Assessment:

- The Grade 3 Assessment in Reading, *Lecture*, and Numeracy and Grade 4 Assessment in French Immersion *Lecture* will take place in the fall of 2018. Information is available at www.edu.gov.mb.ca/k12/assess/gr3/. Schools will use the Collection of Assessment Results (CAR) web application to report student-by-student results to the department in November. Further information will be provided to schools at the start of the 2018/2019 school year.

Middle Years Assessment:

- The Middle Years Assessment of Key Competencies in Mathematics, Reading Comprehension, Expository Writing, and Student Engagement will start in the fall of 2018. Information is available at www.edu.gov.mb.ca/k12/assess/myreporting.html. Schools will use the CAR web application to report student-by-student results to the department between mid-January and the end of February 2019. Further information will be provided to schools at the start of the 2018/2019 school year.

Grade 12 Tests:

- Provincial tests will be administered in the following subjects:
 - English Language Arts
 - *Français langue première, 40S : Langue et communication*
 - *Français langue seconde — immersion, 40S : Langue et communication*
 - Applied Mathematics/*Mathématiques appliquées*
 - Essential Mathematics/*Mathématiques au quotidien*
 - Pre-Calculus Mathematics/*Mathématiques pré-calcul*
- To receive timely and accurate summaries of results and feedback from the department it is crucial to return test-related materials by the deadline dates. The department provides financial support (\$10.00 per mathematics test; \$12.25 per language arts test) to funded independent schools and to school divisions for each test that counts as a provincial test and for which materials are returned on time. The purpose of the financial support is to compensate teachers or provide for release time for marking the tests. This support goes to the jurisdiction in which the students are enrolled in the course.
