We are investing \$10 million in new funds to hire over 100 teachers and 20 educational assistants to create a provincial Manitoba remote learning support centre to support the delivery of remote learning to Manitoba students, their families and the teachers who provide it. This is in addition to \$100 million of funding already committed to support our Restoring Safe Schools plan.

support teachers that are teaching remotely;



support students and families that are learning remotely;



maintain resources for everyone learning and teaching remotely;



ensure remote learning is effective and high quality through monitoring, reporting, training and partnerships.
