

Manitoba Remote Learning Support Centre—Overview

Goal: To ensure that all students have access to and engage in high-quality learning, regardless of the circumstances posed by COVID-19. The provincial remote learning strategy will ensure continuity of learning, build capacity, support educators, and achieve greater consistency.

Why: Educators need support for sustaining remote learning. There is ongoing demand for learning at home. There is varied capacity for remote learning throughout the province and connectivity issues are a provincial concern. A coordinated approach will support a high-quality remote learning framework.

Governance: The provincial remote learning strategy will be operated and implemented in partnership with education stakeholders and school divisions from across the province. A steering committee chaired by Manitoba Education has been established to oversee the work. Regional representatives from school divisions across the province are engaged as part of a provincial advisory council to provide input and to participate in planning and implementation.

Deliverables (below): In partnership with Manitoba Education, representatives from metro, rural, and northern divisions have come together to oversee the design and implementation of a provincial strategy for all system and school leaders, teachers, students, and families.



A framework outlining foundational beliefs and guiding principles for remote learning to promote equitable outcomes by ensuring that all students have access to and engage in high-quality learning.



A provincial repository (English/French) of on-demand, accessible teaching, learning, and assessment resources to support the delivery of remote learning.



Professional learning (English/French) that focuses on mentoring, building capacity and technical proficiency, and enhancing pedagogical approaches.



A system to monitor progress and results, and to report on adoption and progress related to goals.



A remote learning support team dedicated to designing the repository and providing instructional coaching and professional learning.



Learning supports to students who are learning at home due to COVID-19.



Partnerships to enhance remote learning across the province.
