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# INTRODUCTION

## LEARNING RESOURCES FOR EDUCATION FOR SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT, KINDERGARTEN TO GRADE 12

This bibliography with indexes was compiled using the results of learning resources reviews conducted by the *Learning for a Sustainable Future (LSF)* in conjunction with Manitoba and Canadian teachers. LSF is a Canadian non-profit organization founded in 1991 to implement education for sustainable development (ESD) into the formal school systems in Canada.

One of LSF's initiatives has been to review learning resources to identify excellent, relevant resources that support ESD. Teachers who currently teach or have recently taught in a classroom setting within the formal education system have recommended the resources that are listed here.

The review process focused on two main dimensions: quality and curriculum match. The quality and usefulness of the resource has been determined with reference to:

- Sustainability education principles
- Curriculum fit
- Pedagogical methods
- Development of knowledge
- Development of skills
- Development of attitudes/values
- Background information for the teacher
- Background information for the students
- Thoroughness/ ease of use
- Support for teachers

### **Criteria for selecting resources**

- Deal with multiple dimensions of sustainability
- Activities/lesson plans included within the resource
- Activities/lesson plans in the resource are detailed and explicit enough to allow the teacher to teach the concept
- The concept(s) must be a good fit to some age-appropriate curriculum expectation
- Connectivity is a focus!

There's an opportunity for students to make connections between what they are learning and their own daily practices. Practical solutions/opportunities for action outside of the classroom are implicit to the activity.

- An appropriate range of diverse perspectives are given fair treatment in the resource
- Support materials are relevant to lesson descriptions and do not require AV or other resources that may not be available to the teacher
- The activity/activities provided engage students in a fun & creative way
- The activity/activities require an appropriate amount of teacher preparation – not too onerous
- Local/Canadian case studies (as opposed to resources with an American or European focus)

The indexes at the end list the resources by grade, by audience, by suggested use (subjects).
