

Policy for Recognition of Completion of Cadet Training Programs

1. Application

This policy applies to all Grades 9 to 12 schools issuing the Manitoba High School Diploma.

2. Rationale

Students can earn up to two credits for successful completion of the Canadian cadet basic and advanced training programs offered by the

- Royal Canadian Sea Cadets
- Royal Canadian Air Cadets
- Royal Canadian Army Cadets

The cadet credits are recognized as additional credits over and above the minimum number of credits required for graduation with the Manitoba High School Diploma.

3. Policy

The conditions for recognition of cadets credits are as follows:

- Evidence of successful completion of a cadet training program is provided to the school principal.
- One credit can be recognized on the basis of successful completion of a cadet basic training program.
- One additional credit can be recognized on the basis of successful completion of a cadet advanced training program.
- Cadet credits are recognized only as additional credits beyond the minimum number of credits required for high school graduation.
