Downloading the Homeschooling Progress Report Forms

- Ensure you have the most recent free version of Adobe Acrobat Reader on your computer.
- Download the forms to your computer, and save them. Then open a form to begin completing it.
- Remember to save the form prior to submitting it to the Homeschooling Office.

Completing the Homeschooling Progress Report

Homeschooling Progress Reports are the official educational record for each homeschooled child and are filed in the Homeschooling Office. These records may support future enrolment in school or application to a post-secondary institution.

Homeschooling parents are required to submit progress reports for each child in January and June of each homeschooling year. You can find fillable Homeschooling Progress Reports by clicking on the January or June PDF forms on the Notification Package web page.

Parents must report about the four required subject areas of

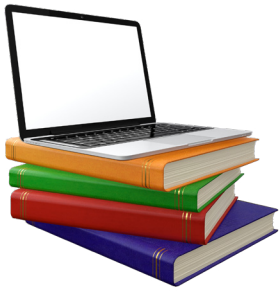
- Language Arts: includes reading, writing, listening, and speaking
- Mathematics
- Science
- Social Studies
- Other: families may report on other areas of study, such as physical education, music, religious studies, languages, art, career development, and more.

Best reporting practices include documenting

- ✓ what a child is doing well
- ✓ what they are struggling with
- ✓ what needs improvement
- ✓ next steps in programming

Parents may assign number or letter grades, but it is not necessary. If a parent is using structured curricula, they can note the units that are completed.



Parents are encouraged to include student resources used to support learning. Parents who make changes to their program outline or student resources after submitting their Student Notification Forms should indicate these changes in the progress reports.

Parents are encouraged to provide detailed comments that describe their child's learning and may provide context by using anecdotal observations. Parents may attach a document since the forms have limited space.

On the January Progress Report, checkboxes on the left-hand side of the report can be used to indicate Satisfactory progress; however, comments about how a child is doing within each subject area contribute to a complete homeschooling record.

The Comments section of the June Progress Report reflects the student learning accomplished since the January Progress Report. Families are encouraged to indicate clearly which subject areas have been completed for the student's grade level and which ones require further work.
