<p>À la ronde 3 Voyager 8^e <i>On parle français</i></p> <p>The short texts introduce students to francophone regions such as La Suisse, Le Congo and Le Maroc.</p>	<p>À la ronde 3 8^e <i>La francophonie</i> <i>Au sommet francophone</i></p> <p>The short texts describe different francophone regions of Canada and provide a list of French-speaking countries.</p>	<p>Boomerang 3 8^e <i>Nous sommes uniques</i></p> <p>This book from the Boomerang collection describes the Metis culture.</p>	<p>C'est parti! 7^e-8^e <i>Le Canada et la culture</i></p> <p>The set has 5 different modules that explore different aspects of culture in Canada such as Le Festival Franco-ontarien, various cities in Quebec, Canadian symbols, and traditional French Canadian cuisine.</p>
<p>Chantons, bougeons 7^e-8^e <i>Amusons-nous</i></p> <p>The resource includes a teacher's guide and a CD for 10 traditional French-Canadian folksongs. This resource is also on line.</p>	<p>Cultur-osité 7^e-8^e <i>Les traditions</i></p> <p>The set has a teacher's guide, 15 copies of <i>La fête en famille</i> (about the traditional Christmas eve réveillon) and 15 copies of <i>Ça swing</i> (about the French-Canadian musical group Swing).</p>	<p>Cultur-osité 7^e <i>Voyages francophones</i></p> <p>The book introduces students to three French-speaking countries such as Haiti, Senegal and Belgium. The set has 2 copies of the book.</p>	

<p>Cultur-osité francophonie 7^e-8^e</p> <p>The set has a teacher's guide, 15 copies of <i>Voyages francophones</i> (about Belgium, Haiti and Senegal) and <i>Le Canada en photos</i> (a photo album of Canadian regions and symbols).</p>	<p>Cultur-osité 7^e</p> <p><i>On s'amuse en français</i></p> <p>The book profiles two teenagers who participate in the French-Canadian games for 13 to 18 year old students.</p>	<p>Échos Pro 3 7^e</p> <p><i>Destination Montréal</i></p> <p>The module explores the sights and sounds of Montreal.</p>	<p>Échos 3 7^e</p> <p><i>Où est Théo?</i></p> <p>The reader tries to find Theo using the clues given on each page.</p>

The last chapter presents the francophone flags of Canadian provinces and territories.</p>	<p>Des jeux d'autres pays 7^e-8^e</p> <p>This book feature simple directions on how to play a variety of games from different countries.</p>	<p>Mon réseau ma vie 1 7^e-8^e</p> <p><i>On part à l'aventure</i></p> <p>Students explore a variety of activities and experiences advertised for the following regions: Mont -Tremblant, Aquarium du Québec, West Edmonton Mall and Martinique. One of the projects includes selecting a tourist attraction for a group activity.</p>	<p>Quel temps fait-il Christophe? 7^e-8^e</p> <p>The book compares how weather affects daily activities in Canada and in Cameroun. The book features short texts and simple sentences. The set has five copies of the book, a CD audio and a BIG book.</p>
<p>Qu'est-ce que tu aimes manger, Monique? 7^e-8^e</p> <p>The book compares food eaten in Canada and in Martinique. The book features short texts and simple sentences. The set has five copies of the book, a CD audio and a BIG book.</p>	<p>Qu'est-ce que tu portes, Simone? 7^e-8^e</p> <p>The book describes clothing worn in Canada and Senegal. The book features short texts and simple sentences.</p>	<p>Mon réseau, ma vie 2 8^e</p> <p><i>On s'informe</i></p> <p>Students describe their homes, communities, their family and social activities. Students can also read interesting articles about life and food in France and Switzerland.</p>	<p>D'un océan à l'autre 7^e-8^e</p> <p>This module explores the Festival du Voyageur and the Festival de Caraquet. Students will also find information about the Métis culture. The kit has 24 copies of the student module and an audio CD.</p>
