# AU MANITOBA ON S'AMUSE EN FRANÇAIS 

## Sondage

Learning situation: To review colours and to introduce the linguistic structures, Je regarde..., Ma couleur préférée est... To participate in a survey that integrates colours.

## Teacher modelling and oral interaction:

NOTE: This learning session may be divided into several lessons.

- The teacher reviews the vocabulary for describing the colours of leaves by modelling the same linguistic structure found in the comptine, Fevilles d'automne. The teacher points to four different groups of leaves that are placed around the classroom and says, Je regarde les fevilles rouges. Je regarde les feuilles jaunes. Je regarde les feuilles orange. Je regarde les feuilles brunes. The teacher repeats each structure a couple of times to allow time for the students to process the information. Then the teacher remodels each structure several times and invites the students to chime in.
- Next, the teacher remodels and interacts with five students. Je regarde les fevilles rouges. Et toi? (Qu'est-ce que tu regardes?) The student replies, Je regarde les fevilles jaunes.
- To extend the learning, students walk around the room and stop in front of a group of leaves and say to the person next to them, Je regarde les feuilles jaunes. Et toi?
- During the next class, the teacher remodels the structure from the previous day and interacts with several students. This interaction leads to the listening of the comptine, Feuilles d'automne. The teacher models reading strategies and explores the rhyme with the students.
- Afterwards, the teacher models the writing of a complete sentence using the structure from the comptine, Je regarde... The students write in their journals using this model to write their own sentence and they illustrate it thus demonstrating their understanding of colours. They also read their sentence to a classmate.
- As a follow-up activity to support listening and oral communication skills, the teacher will hold one leaf and model, Ma couleur préférée est jaune. Et toi? The student may reply with the same colour or may change to another colour. Ma couleur préférée est rouge.
- The teacher models this several times with different students. Once the students are familiar with these structures, they interact with partners. Next, the teacher conducts a survey (see chart on the next page) by asking students to place an $x$ beside their favourite colour and say, Ma couleur préférée est... The teacher and student determine the most popular and least popular colour by counting preferences indicated in the graph. For example, Rouge est la couleur préférée de la classe.
- The survey is also an opportunity for students to circulate and to find out which of their classmates prefer a certain colour. They say, Ma couleur préférée est... Et toi?
