



## Attention! Allez! Arrêtez!

**Learning situation:** To introduce traffic signals and to interact using the following commands:

**Feu rouge – Arrêtez!**  
**Feu jaune – Attention!**  
**Feu vert – Allez!**



### Teacher modelling and oral interaction:

- The teacher models the three commands using three coloured circles as described above. The teacher asks the students to walk around the room with her. **Marchez avec moi.** As the teacher holds up the red circle and says, **Feu rouge!** all the students stop and say, **Arrêtez!** They then continue walking until the teacher holds up the green circle and says, **Feu vert.** The students say, **Allez!** and walk faster **but do not run.** The third circle is then held up as the teacher says, **Feu jaune.** The students say, **Attention!** and tip-toe around the room as they get ready to stop.
- As an extension activity to the theme of transportation, the students mime one of the following modes of transport, **J'aime aller à bicyclette., J'aime aller en autobus., J'aime aller en camion., J'aime aller en auto.** instead of walking.

### VARIATION:

- Some students may want to lead the activity.
- As a follow-up activity to support student learning, the teacher may choose to explore the rhyme, **Arrêtez!**
