Attention! Allez! Arrêtez!

Learning situation: To introduce traffic signals and to interact using the following commands:

Feu rouge – Arrêtez! Feu jaune – Attention! Feu vert – Allez!



Teacher modelling and oral interaction:

- The teacher models the three commands using three coloured circles as described above. The teacher asks the students to walk around the room with her. Marchez avec moi. As the teacher holds up the red circle and says, Feu rouge! all the students stop and say, Arrêtez! They then continue walking until the teacher holds up the green circle and says, Feu vert. The students say, Allez! and walk faster but do not run. The third circle is then held up as the teacher says, Feu jaune. The students say, Attention! and tip-toe around the room as they get ready to stop.
- As an extension activity to the theme of transportation, the students mime one of the following modes of transport, J'aime aller à bicyclette., J'aime aller en autobus., J'aime aller en camion., J'aime aller en auto. instead of walking.

VARIATION:

- Some students may want to lead the activity.
- As a follow-up activity to support student learning, the teacher may choose to explore the rhyme, Arrêtez!
