



Vocabulaire de la salle de classe

Learning situation: To introduce simple, practical, and everyday expressions used in the classroom.

Teacher modelling and interaction:

- The teacher models several common expressions in context, for example: **bonjour**, **au revoir**, **s'il vous plaît**, **merci**, **de rien**, **j'ai fini**. During interactions with students, the teacher consistently uses classroom expressions in French. After a given amount of time, the teacher prompts students to also use them.
- For example, the teacher consistently greets students and bids them goodbye by saying, **bonjour** and **au revoir**. Eventually, the students are prompted to also greet the teacher and bid him goodbye using the expressions that have been modelled.
- The teacher may choose to use these expressions throughout the day to infuse more French in classroom routines. These expressions may also be used in the *message du jour* and may also find their way onto the word wall.
