Comment t'appelles-tu?

Learning situation: To interact using the linguistic structures, **Bonjour**, **je m'appelle... Et toi?**, **Comment t'appelles-tu?**

Teacher modelling and oral interaction:

- The teacher models the linguistic structures and guides the students to answer and ask a question. For example, Bonjour, je m'appelle... (name, pointing to self). He then asks, Et toi? (pointing) or Comment t'appelles-tu? (pointing again to the student). This linguistic structure is modelled several times as the teacher interacts with different students. The teacher then asks the students to sit in a circle and they can take turns asking and answering the modelled structures. In subsequent lessons, the students reuse the linguistic structures as they interact with each other.
- Once the students are familiar with these structures, the teacher explores the two songs Bonjour mes amis and Bonjour (during different lessons). These two songs can become part of the classroom routine at the beginning of the class as a way to greet the students and at the end of the class/day to wrap up the lesson or as a transition to the next classroom activity.

VARIATION: A teacher may use a cloth puppet and pretend to be the puppet, asking the same questions. The teacher then hands the puppet to a child and he or she becomes the puppet, **Bonjour**, **je m'appelle KiKi. Et toi?** or **Comment t'appelles-tu?**
